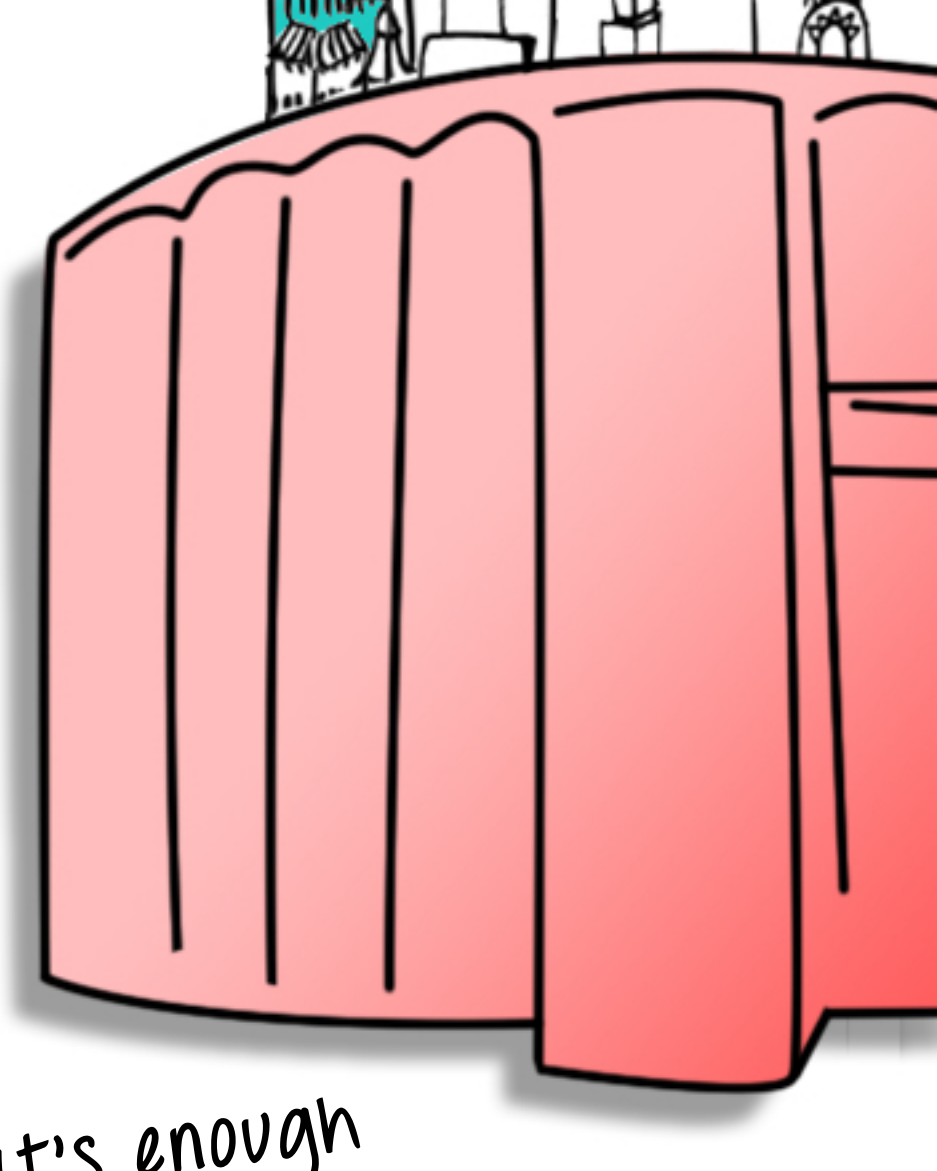
Every year, approximately

women and

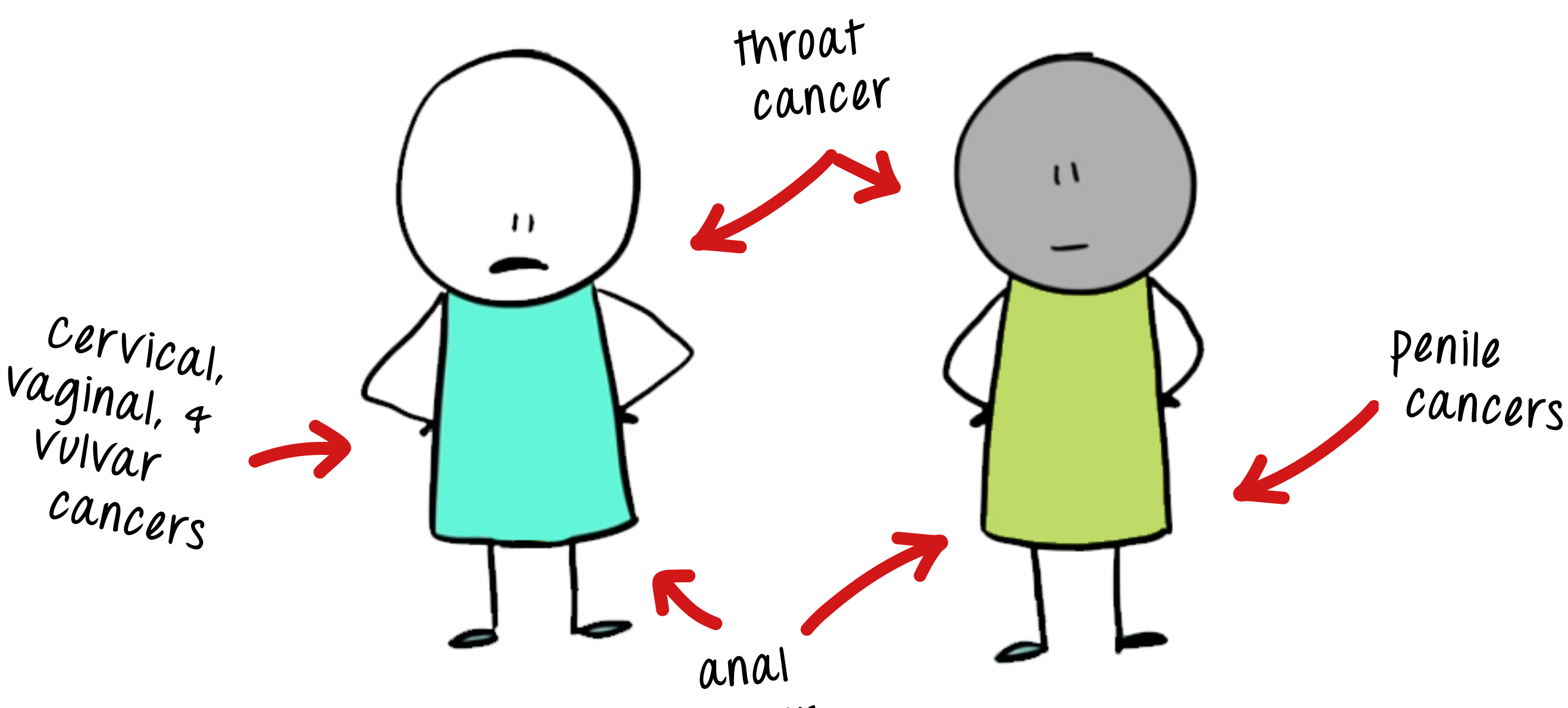
**12,100** ♂

men are affected by cancers caused by HPV.

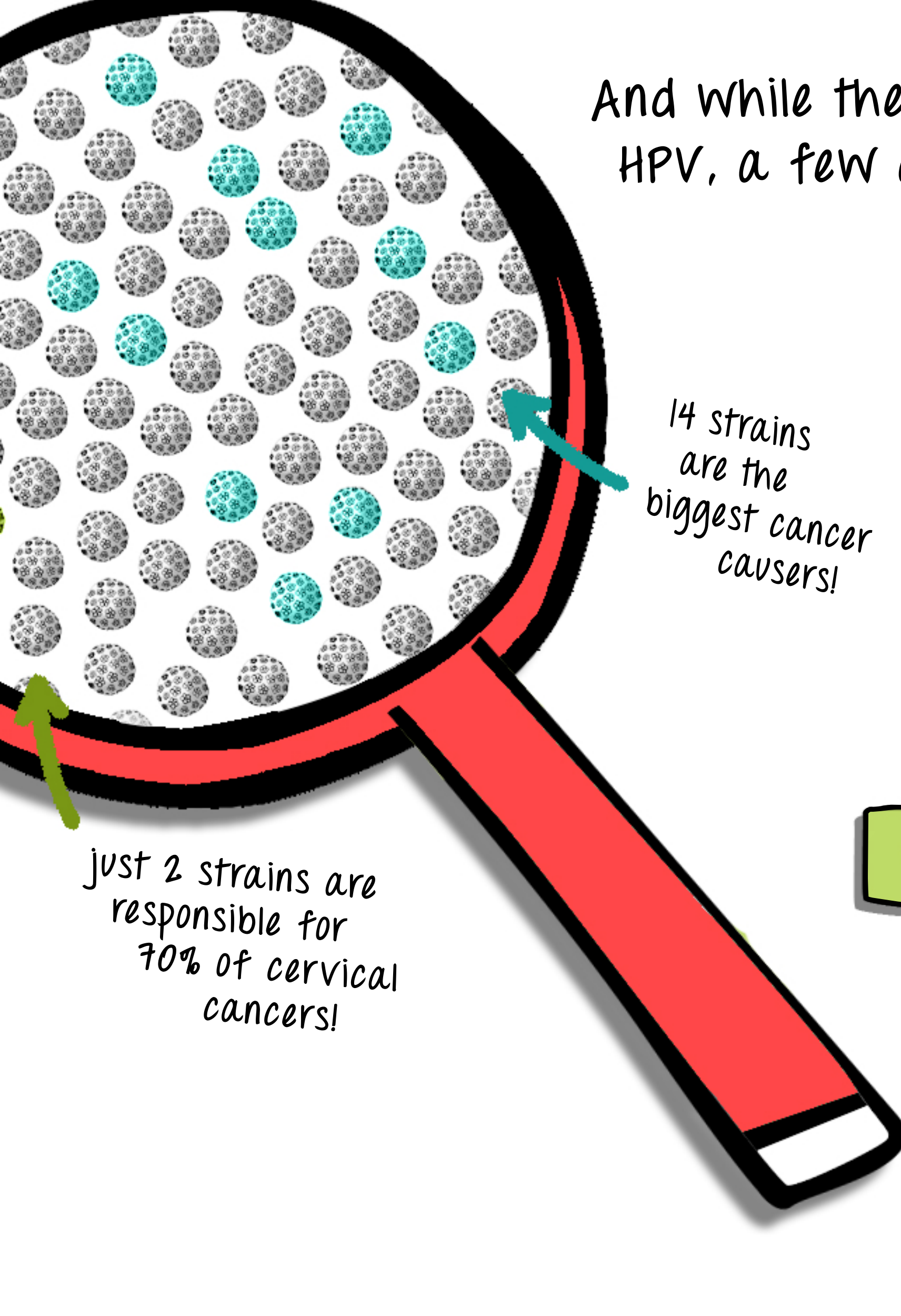


That's enough people to fill Madison Square Garden 1.5 times!
